Topics:

- Friday Morning – International / Premier Drills & Skills – e.g. Serps and Threadles – using jumps and tunnels
- Friday Afternoon – International / Premier Sequences– Put your skills to the test with longer sequences
- Saturday Morning – Got Foundation? - For older puppies (8 months plus) and any age that wants to revisit foundation skills. Tunnels, wings or low jumps only. Nancy will adjust to the skills/ages of the dogs participating.
- Saturday Afternoon – Master Handling – Dog path, handler path - a workshop focused on helping handlers identify their path relative to the dog's path to better show the lines between obstacles clearly and not to interfere with the dogs line unintentionally.
- Sunday Morning - International / Premier– Dog path decision making - Turn right or left, short way long way, wrap or go with the flow? This session will focus on choosing the dogs line and then applying efficient handling to show the line to your dog.
- Sunday Afternoon – Master Handling – Dog path, handler path - a workshop focused on helping handlers identify their path relative to the dog's path to better show the lines between obstacles clearly and not to interfere with the dogs line unintentionally.

Nancy's Bio

Nancy Gyes has been involved in dog agility since 1990 and she has been involved in dog training sports for the last 35 years. She was active in competition and pet obedience, tracking and behavior counseling for pet owners before discovering agility in 1990. A few of her career highlights: Nancy was on the AKC World Team 7 times; 4 years with Scud and three years with Riot. Riot earned a silver medal in the standard class at Worlds in 2001 and the Gold in the standard class in 2002. Riot was the USDAA National Champion twice and the AKC National Champion twice as well. Her border collies Scud and Wicked also won USDAA National Championships. Nancy's border collie Ace won the Bronze Medal in 2009 at the European Open Championships and in 2011 Nancy was on the EO team that earned a bronze medal for the Team event. Nancy has been on the European Open Team 5 times, and in the finals 4 of those years. Nancy has been the Coach of the American Kennel Club World Team since 2006, she is experienced working with many breeds having put an ADCh on 3 mixed breeds, 2 mini dogs, as well as 8 border collies and in every jump height from 12 to 30 inches. She has also put 15 MACH's on her various border collies Scud, Riot, Wicked, Ace, Scoop and Pie.
